We are pleased to invite you to participate in the ***11th International Workshop on Seismic Microzoning and Risk Reduction*** to be held in Granada, Spain, from October 3rd to 5th, 2016, and kindly request the distribution of this announcement among your colleagues.

The workshop is focused to discuss methodologies and results on Earthquakes, Engineering Seismology, Seismic Hazard, Earthquake Engineering, Seismic Risk, Earthquake Disaster Mitigation and Management, and other related subjects applicable in urban areas.

Lessons learnt from recent earthquakes make clear a persistent need to evaluate and reducing the seismic risk, especially in populated areas. Therefore, a reliable and not expensive evaluation of seismic hazard, earthquake hazards, vulnerability, and damage aimed at risk reduction to be worldwide applied is needed. Additionally, a better assessment and understanding of the seismic risk application-oriented is achieved when there is a closer cooperation among earthquake engineers, engineering seismologists and civil protection technicians. Thus, this Workshop is organized to bring together innovative academics and risk reduction experts to a common forum.

Researchers, professionals, risk experts or practitioners and emergency managers are encouraged to participate and contribute to the scientific sessions, possibly able to promote multidisciplinary discussions and developments.

Both oral and poster presentations are welcome. PhD students and post-doc researchers are especially welcome.

This two and a half-day workshop provides a unique opportunity to meet and share ideas, results, and practical experiences about new methods and pragmatic tools to assess, mitigate, and respond to earthquakes at urban scale. The workshop stresses the importance of a multi-disciplinary approach in Earthquake Disaster Prevention.
